

**An Articulation Agreement
Between
Rend Lake and Illinois State University**

If a student completes the Agri-Business and all other appropriate requirements for an Applied Science Degree at Rend Lake College and is admitted to Illinois State University, that student shall be eligible for this Articulation Agreement

- 1 This Articulation Agreement is only appropriate for students who transfer from Rend Lake College with an Applied Science Degree in Agri-Business and pursue a Bachelor of Science Degree in Agri-Business from Illinois State University
- 2 These students must complete the following course requirements at Rend Lake College

- Requirements are from 2006-2007 Illinois State University Catalog


