

**An Articulation Agreement

If a student completes the Agri-Business and all other appropriate requirements for Applied Science Degree at Wabash Valley College and is admitted to Illinois State University that student shall be eligible for this Articulation Agreement

- 1 This Articulation Agreement is only appropriate for students who transfer from Wabash Valley College with an Applied Science Degree in Agri-Business and pursue Bachelor of Science Degree in Agri-Business from Illinois State University




